We have initiated a very important stewardship program to help our parish. It is designed to better connect with parishioners and sustain our offertory.

- •If you can believe, it takes \$18,500 per week to run our parish. With current weekly offertory at approximately \$7,000 and a 25% decline experienced over the fourmonth period during COVID-19, we will have to remain prudent with expenses and still find a way to serve the pastoral needs of our 1,150 parishioners.
- •Some of you may have already received a letter detailing the Program and highlighting its necessity. If you have not received it, please be on the lookout this week. Please prayerfully read it over and consider responding by mailing the response card included to the parish office or filling one out at www.cfbq.org/PSP.
- •If each year we all do a little more, over time, it will make a major difference not only in our parish community but also in our spiritual life and in our discipleship of helping to do God's work.
